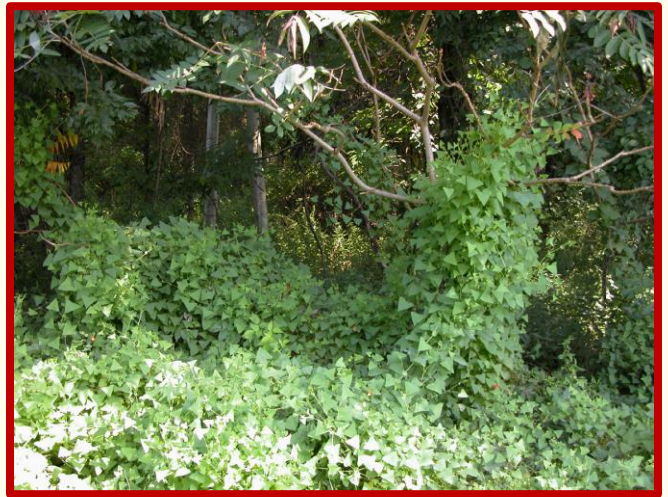
The Mark Twain Library and Redding Garden Club present...
