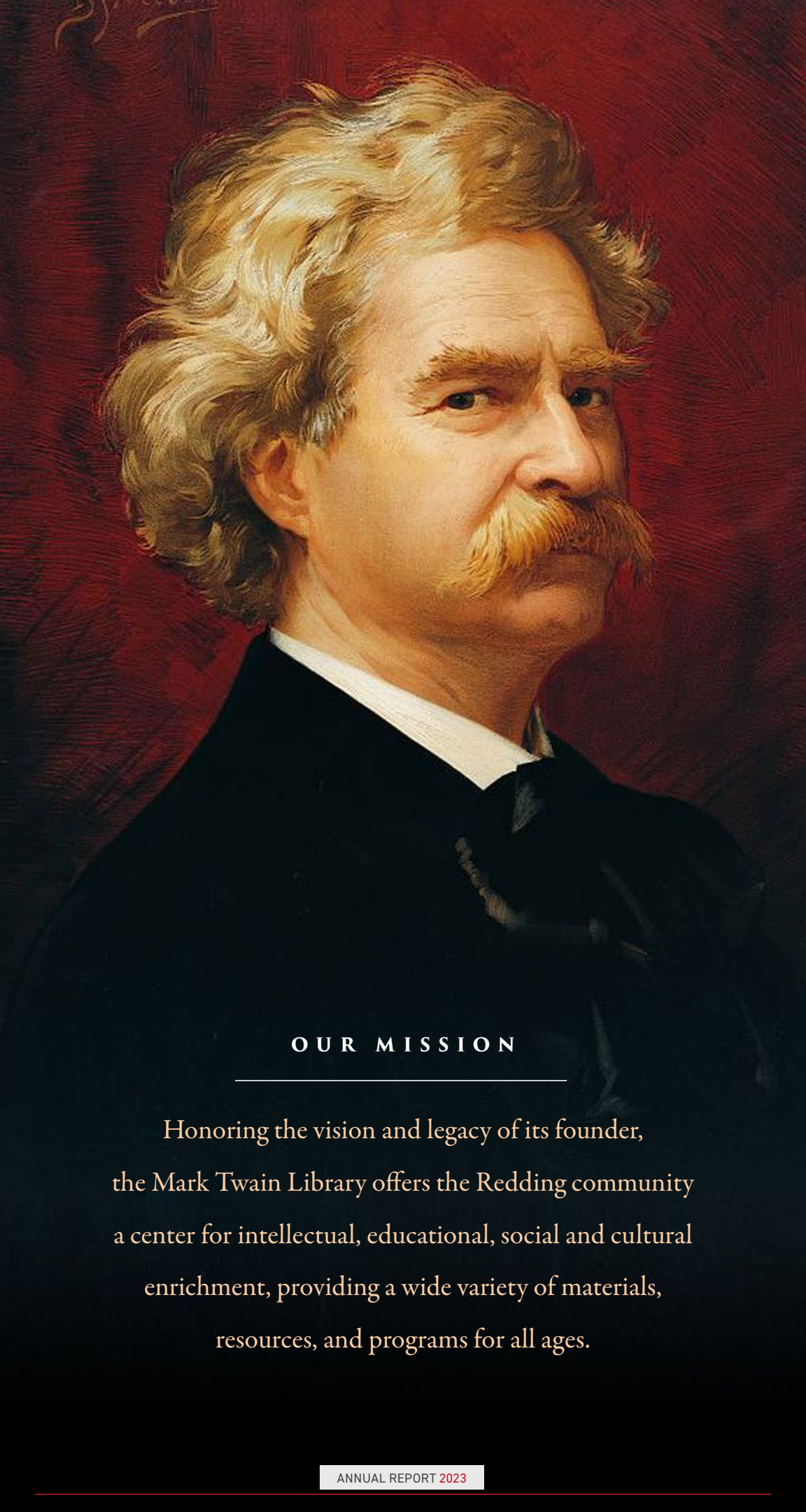

REMARKS FROM THE PRESIDENT

Welcome to the 115th Annual Meeting of the Mark Twain Library Association. Our founder would no doubt be very pleased to know that this is the 115th year (!) of meetings to celebrate the continuing work of this special place we call the Mark Twain Library.

What makes this so very special? You! You, who have made the Library the cultural, informational, and educational center of our town. You, who have supported the fundraisers which keep the doors open and allow us to provide materials and programming for the community. You, who have come to not only support the Library, but have a genuine affection, a true love for this place.

This past year our Library has been impacted in several ways:

- We have many new families who have moved into our town.
- Our award-winning adult programming continues with more and more people returning physically to the Library.
- We heard from the community the need for space outside. We applied for, and received some funding from an ARPA grant to build an outdoor space suitable for our library. Construction will begin soon.
- Our fundraisers continue to get support from the community and generate much needed funds to keep the Library operating.
 - The Art Show celebrated its 50th anniversary last December.
 - The Book Fair is regionally famous for its offerings with book dealers and enthusiasts coming from several states.
 - The Frog Frolic Festival signals spring in Redding, and a colorful day of fun for everyone.
 - Pudd'nhead celebrates "humor is mankind's greatest blessing," in the tradition of our founder.
 - The Annual Appeal is an ongoing effort to generate funds to allow the Library to continue to flourish.
- We are forever indebted to the Town of Redding for their support. The Town provides about 60% of the funding needed for the Library—with the remainder coming from our fundraisers. This support assures our ability to continue the work that our founder created all those years ago.

As you can see, all of these programs and events start and end with you.

REMARKS FROM THE LIBRARY DIRECTOR

“To us our house was not unsentient matter –
it had a heart and a soul and eyes to see us with, and approvals and
solicitudes and deep sympathies; it was of us, and we were in its confidence,
and lived in its grace and in the peace of its benediction.”

Recently while out and about in town, a Redding resident told me that the Library is her second favorite place. I thanked her for the comment and posed a follow up, “What is your first favorite place then?” She laughed. “My home!”

I am honored to work at the Mark Twain Library, an institution that is so beloved by the community that many consider it a second home.

When representatives from Wreaths Across America asked for a cemetery list to identify local veterans, our librarians were able to locate it. When middle school students wanted to explore their love of robotics, the Library connected them with an instructor and materials. When parents of young children needed a place to hang out this winter where their kids could read and play, we refurbished our story time room.

During a year when libraries were in the headlines both locally and nationally, our library remained a center for intellectual freedom and equal access to library materials. If Mark Twain were to visit the Library that he gave to the Town of Redding back in 1908, I think he would be proud of the enduring memorial he bestowed upon us.

PROGRAMS

Our award-winning programs help solidify our reputation as the figurative center of town. We are the place neighbors turn to for entertainment and inspiration. This year saw the return of our popular and renowned Hermes Art Series, with a performance by the bluegrass duo Compton & Newberry. Another highlight was the tremendous joy felt by everyone who came to Take Your Child to the Library Day in February. Over 300 of Redding's youngest residents came for a performance by Al de Cant with special guest Pete the Cat. It was a delightful way to introduce new residents to the Library as well as welcome our story time regulars.



FUNDRAISERS

As a non-profit association library, our operating budget is only partially funded by the Town of Redding. In addition to an Annual Appeal, four seasonal fundraisers hope to make up the rest, which is a significant sum: \$400,000. These volunteer driven labors of love have become part of the unique fabric of Redding.

FROG FROLIC FESTIVAL

Crowd-pleasing activities for the young, food trucks and live music make up a magical fun-for-all-ages day, providing a **springtime** infusion for the Library's coffers.



BOOK FAIR

Labor Day in Redding = The Mark Twain Library Book Fair. For 6+ decades, this back breakingly beloved event has contributed to the prosperity of our library. It proudly bears the mantle as the oldest and one of the largest book fairs in New England.



PUDD'NHEAD FESTIVAL

In the **fall**, we hail our funny founder with the Pudd'nhead Festival, while raising much-needed funds for the library's operations.



ART SHOW

Every **December** the Library turns into a stunning gallery with inspiring works of art hanging in and around the stacks, with 35% of the sales going directly to support the Library.

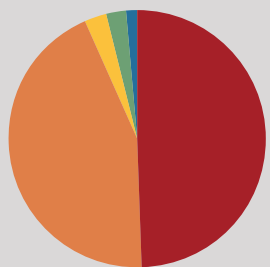

OPERATING REVENUES

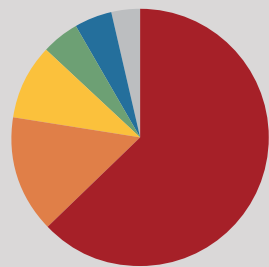

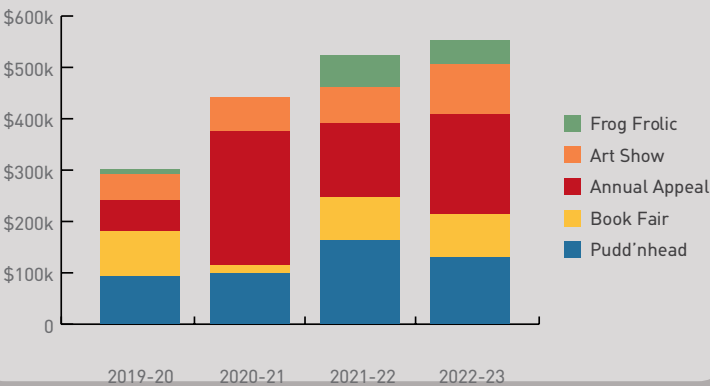
